Pre-requisites for Online Courses

1. Equipment/Facilities required for attending Programmes in Online mode (such as good internet connectivity on Mobile, Laptop, Tab etc. and Internet Platform) has to be managed by the participants. Organizers will not be responsible for poor internet connectivity at the end of the participants.
2. All the participants must provide Whatsapp number and email ID.
3. Submission of MCQs, Quiz, Assignments, Evaluation etc. are compulsory as per requirements of the Course.
4. The Centre reserves the right to alter the terms and conditions of the Course as and when required.
5. Digitally signed e-certificates will be provided to the participants who will successfully complete the assignments/evaluation process, attendance etc.
6. All the participants must ensure the attendance and punctuality during the entire length of the Course.

The teacher participants cannot attend any other assignments, classes, meetings etc. (online/offline) during the course timings (9:30 am to 5:00 pm daily), as it is a full time online course, as per UGC guidelines. 8. In the online course, the participants will be asked to turn on their camera to have better interaction since it will be online. Participants need to be careful while facing the camera and it is always good to look presentable.
